

## **How do I know if I or my organisation is eligible for access to these e-resources?**

INASP supports and negotiates access to e-resources in developing and emerging countries for the following institutions.

- University departments
- University libraries
- Not-for-profit research institutions and centres
- Higher education institutions
- Colleges
- Polytechnics
- Teaching hospitals
- Professional training schools
- Local, regional and national non-government organisations (NGOs)
- Indigenous Civil Society Organisations (CSOs)
- Government ministries, offices and agencies

Access is also available to health professionals, agricultural extension workers and other professions with a not-for-profit remit working in remote areas, when associated with one of the above institutions.

In some countries and for some publishers there may be additional restrictions, for example based on the license agreement or consortia arrangements.

If you are not sure whether you are eligible to access a resource please contact your Country Coordinator.
