## Downloading a paper through PERI

Please note that this process is slightly different for every resource, but the steps should be similar.

### Select your resource

- You can find this by going to <http://www.inasp.info/>, selecting your country, clicking GO and then choosing your resource and following the link to the publisher's url, or from your library's web site

### Open the url

- Click on the url, you should see a welcome screen
- If not, read the section on Barriers below

### Search

- You can usually either browse journals for articles or conduct a specific search

### Download

- You may get the option to download a file in pdf or html or save it to your disk
- Select your option by clicking the link
- You can then open and print your article
- If this does not happen, read the section on Barriers below

### Example

#### Select your resource

- You can find this by going to <http://www.inasp.info/>, selecting your country, clicking GO and then choosing your resource and following the link to the publisher's url, or from your library's web site
- Select Blackwell Publishing <http://www.inasp.info/file/557/blackwell-publishing.html>

#### Open the url

- Under URL to platform/collection access or Website for further information, click <http://www.blackwell-synergy.com/>

#### Search

- Browse by journals
- Click on the Browse tab and select 'P' or use the Quicklink and scroll down to Perspectives on Psychological Science
- Select Perspectives on Psychological Science
- This is a free sample issue
- Click on the date to enter the issue
- Select the article which interests you

#### Download

- Click Full text article to download the article.
