## New journals on NepJOL

## Visitors to NepJOL

Any statistics are difficult to standardise and they often raise more questions than they answer, but the following

information is indicative of usage and may help editors to develop and promote their presence on NepJOL.

Google Analytics shows that from November 2007 to 10 January 2008, there have been 3 939 visitors to the NepJOL website. The graph below shows visitors from Dec 11 2007 to Jan 10 2008.

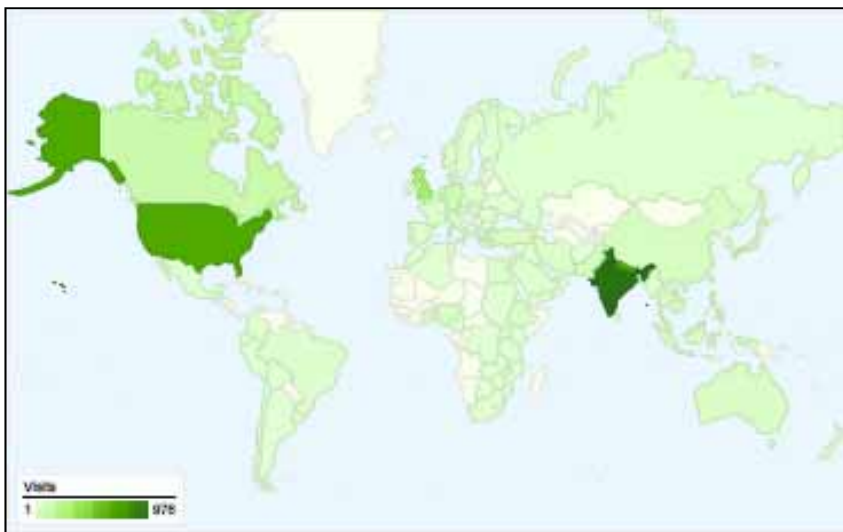
Visitors to NepJOL came from 115 countries: the top three sources for visitors were: India (976), USA (662) and Nepal (657). The number of visits is greater than the number of visitors because some visit more than once.

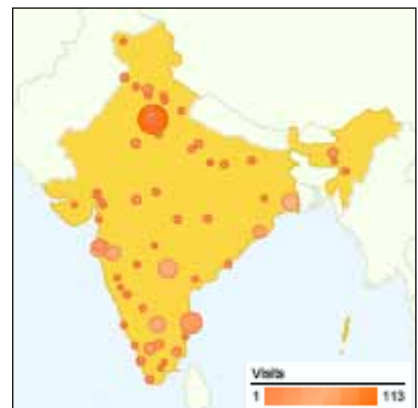
Visitors to NepJOL between Dec 11 2007 and Jan 10 2008

4,342 visits came from 115 countries/territories

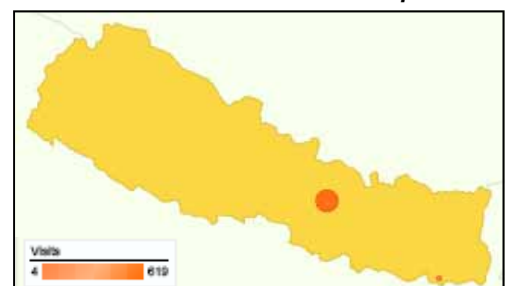
Location of visitors from India

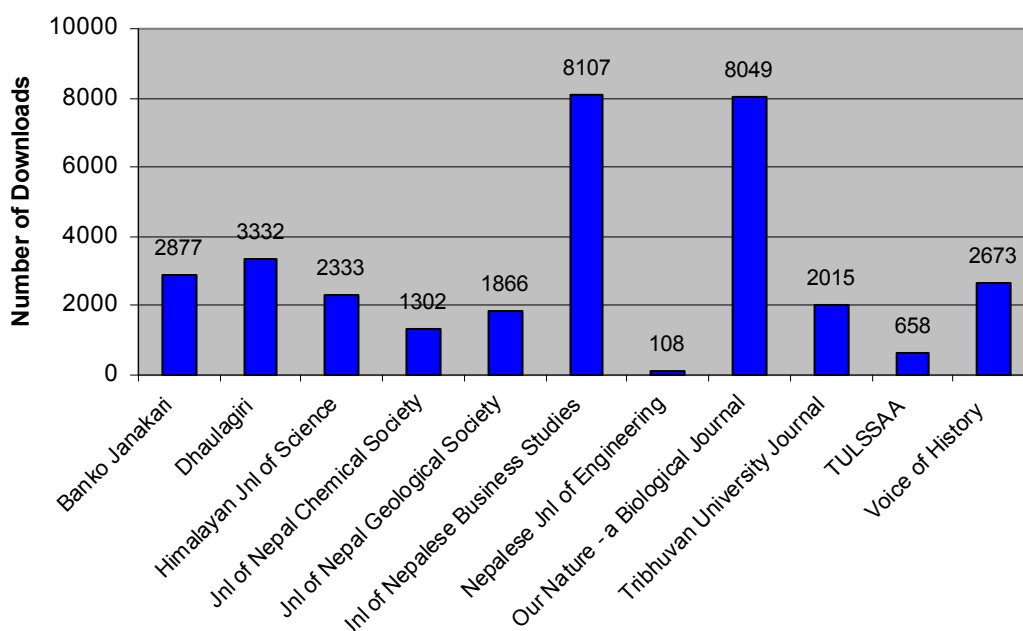
