4 journals have joined PhilJOL since July 2008 giving a total of 26 journals. The new journals are:

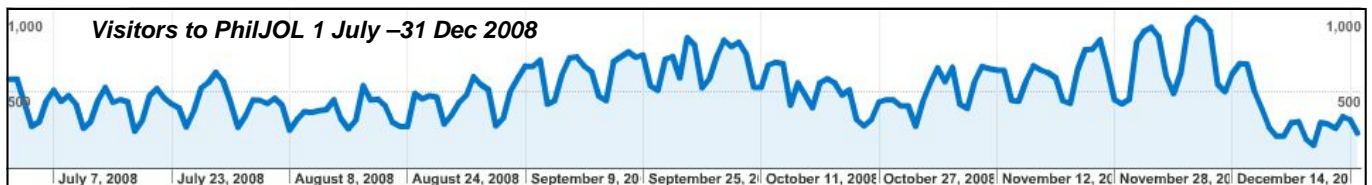
*Emilio Aguinaldo College Research Bulletin*

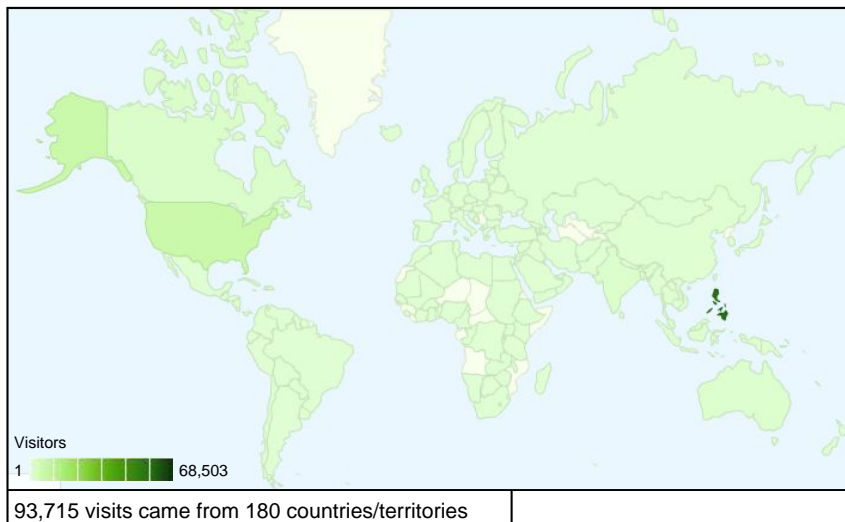
## Visitors to PhilJOL

Google Analytics shows that from 1 July—31 December 2008, there were 93,715 visits from 180 countries. The top three sources for visitors were: Philippines (68,503 visits from 56 cities), USA (7,909 visits from 2,063 cities) and Canada (1,669 visits from 145 cities). This shows excellent usage from the Philippines itself.

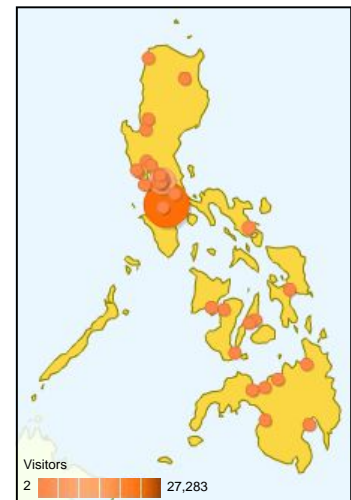
The graph on the next page shows visits each month since May 2008 when PhilJOL began. It indicates that there has been good usage of the site, but the drop in visits toward the end of the year highlights the need to keep loading new content so that visitors will return to the site.



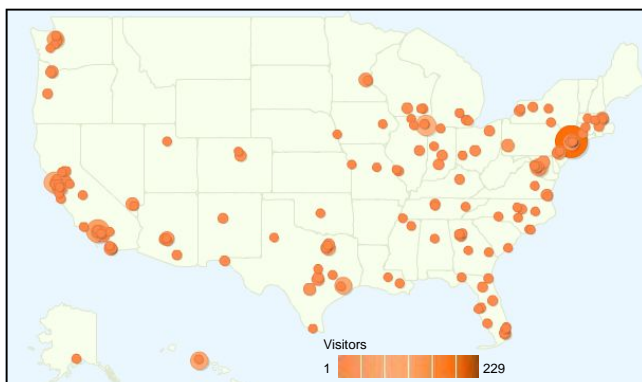
Global distribution visitors to PhilJOL 1 July—31 Dec 2008



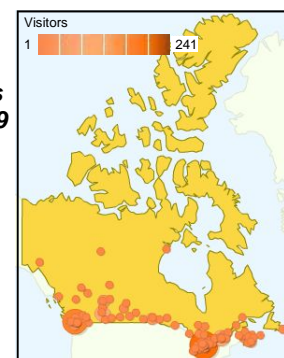
Location of visitors from the Philippines—68,503 from 56 cities



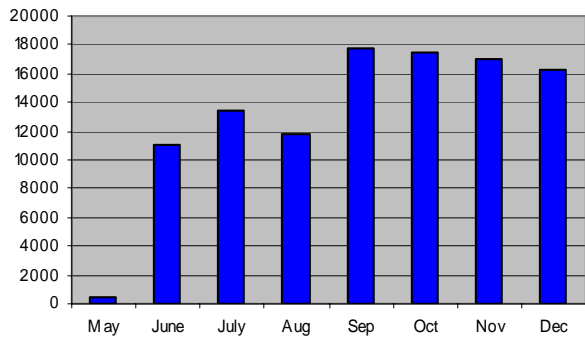
Location of visitors from the USA—7,909 from 2,063 cities

### Number of article views

At the end of December 2008, there were 69 issues and 601 articles of which 453 were full text.

The chart below shows the number of view of full text articles for the PhilJOL journals from July—Dec 2008. A logarithmic scale has had to be used because of the wide variation in values. 155,423 articles were viewed during this period. *Malay* has the highest number of views (71,568) followed by the *Loyola Schools Review* with 12,140. The graph also shows the average number of downloads per article for each journal and *Malay* has the highest with 1,491.
