She started with INASP as the Training Officer working with programme staff to support the quality of training across the organization, including the facilitation of pedagogy workshops and the development of training materials and toolkits.

Annelise comes from a diverse professional background which includes: training teachers at a Junior Teacher Training College in Vietnam; working as a long-term freelance trainer for an international volunteer organisation; supporting the strategic development of regional and country offices in Africa and South Asia working in information and communications for development; project managing a research, communications and influencing project on women's collective action in agricultural markets for a large international NGO, providing direct training and mentoring support on personal security and security management for the same international NGO, managing the quality of risk education, non-technical survey and impact assessment activities for an international humanitarian mine action agency and producing quality assurance standards, competency frameworks, training modules and resource materials throughout her career. Direct country experience includes Vietnam, Azad Kashmir, Lebanon, Kurdistan, Cyprus, South Sudan, Angola, CAR, DRC, Uganda, Ethiopia, Zambia and Sierra Leone.
