Biography:

Clara is INASP's senior programme specialist on evidence-informed policy making. She was Programme Director of the VakaYiko Consortium, until March 2017, leading an international team to build the capacity of policymakers to use research evidence in Ghana, Zimbabwe, South Africa and Uganda. Besides designing and implementing interventions to support research use across different regions, Clara contributes to the development of the INASP organisation and programme strategies. She has carried out various consultancy assignments on improving organisations' research-uptake strategies.

Clara previously worked as an independent consultant on policy influence and evidence-informed policy in various contexts, including Africa, Latin America and Asia. She has also worked closely with the Research and Policy in Development (RAPID) programme in the ODI to coordinate the Evidence-Based in Development Network (ebpdn). She was formerly based in Argentina at the think tank CIPPEC, where she spent over five years developing the policy influence and evaluation capacities of Latin American think tanks and coordinating the Latin American network of ebpdn.
